For the period July 1, 2017 to Jan. 1, 2018, our income has been \$45,503, our expenses \$19,461, and our net revenue was \$26,042. Our Operating Reserve (rainy day fund) is \$40,245.

5. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT -

The Executive Director listed the accomplishments made in 2017-2018. These included the annual meeting in 2017, the Executive Director transition, and the completed workshops listed above. (There was lots of interest in how this insurance would work.) A new contract was made with the DWR to allow their employees to attend CWEMF workshops. The future goals will be to accomplish items from the Strategic Plan, to present more workshops, and hold the 2019 annual meeting.
